

Jackson Moose HOME GAME COVID-19 GUIDELINES

PLEASE READ BEFORE PURCHASING TICKETS. If you are not comfortable in this type of setting, please do not purchase a ticket.

- Attendees are asked to not attend games if in the prior fourteen days she/he or any household member exhibits signs/symptoms indicative of COVID-19 infection. Symptoms of COVID-19 can include fever (>100.4) or feverishness, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills or shaking chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, and new loss of taste or smell.
- Respect Social Distancing guidelines of 6ft between groups
- All Tickets must be purchased online in advance, no walk in ticket sales allowed, no exceptions.
- Temperatures of all attendees will be taken upon arrival at the rink by digital thermometer at front entrance
- Beer tokens available for purchase, cash only, at ID Check station. Beer tokens are cleaned at night after one time use for drink purchase
- ATM available for use, with Hand Sanitizer station positioned at ATM
- Snow King Ice Arena Entrance is through the sliding doors and Exit is through the push doors.
- All attendees are required to wear a face covering while inside the rink at all times, unless eating and drinking while seated.
- Face coverings and gloves will be worn by rink & gameday staff at all times during the game.
- Spitting anywhere in or around a rink or team during games is prohibited.
- There will be no handshake line at the end of games. Opposing teams will line up on the blue line and recognize their opponent with a stick tap on the ice.
- Attendees should leave rink asap after the game is complete.
- Given the changing pandemic environment, these guidelines may change at any time. Additional guidelines will follow as the COVID-19 pandemic continues to evolve.

Assumption of the Risk and waiver of Liability Relating to Coronavirus/COVID-19

The novel coronavirus, COVID-19, has been declared a worldwide pandemic by the World Health Organization. COVID-19 is extremely contagious, and is believed to spread mainly from person-to-person contact. As a result, federal, state, and local governments and federal and state health agencies recommend social distancing and have in many locations, prohibited the congregation of groups of people.

You understand that the risk of becoming exposed to or infected by COVID-19 at the Center may result from the actions, omissions, or negligence of yourself and others, including, but not limited to Center Staff, and fellow skaters and their families.

By entering the Center, you voluntarily agree to assume all of the foregoing risks and accept sole responsibility for any injury to yourself (including, but not limited to, personal injury, disability, and death), illness, damage, loss, claim, liability, or expense, of any kind, that you may experience or incur in connection with your attendance at the Center. You hereby release, covenant not to sue, discharge, and hold harmless the Center, its employees, agents, and representatives, of and from the Claims, including all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses of any kind arising out of or relating thereto. You understand and agree that this release includes any Claims based on the actions, omissions, or negligence of the Center, its employees, agents, and representatives, whether a COVID-19 infection occurs before, during, or after participation at the Center.
