We have developed these regulations for Jackson Hole Moose Hockey games. For anyone entering the rink, please be sure to take responsibility with these regulations so we can continue to use the Snow King Sports & Events Center. We have worked closely with Jackson Youth Hockey to develop these regulations in conjunction with their specific guidelines, noted below.

Covid-19 Protocols:

The Snow King Sports & Events Center (The Center) has developed the following regulations for Jackson Hole Moose Hockey Games. These apply to all individuals entering the rink.

- **All individuals are required to wear a face covering while inside The Center AT ALL TIMES.** *A "Face Covering" means a covering made from cloth, fabric, or other soft or permeable material, without holes, that covers the nose and mouth and surrounding areas of the lower face"*
- Individuals are asked to not to enter the Center if in the prior fourteen days she/he or any household member exhibits signs/symptoms indicative of COVID-19 infection. Symptoms of COVID-19 can include fever (>100.4) or feverishness, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills or shaking chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, and new loss of taste or smell.
- Quarantined individuals are not allowed to attend any event at The Center, and individuals with immune deficiencies or other elevated risk factors should not attend any event at The Center.
- **NO PUBLIC TICKET SALES.** Each player will get 2 tickets for guests to enter The Center to watch the game. No physical tickets will limit contact between guests and staff.
- **NO OUTSIDE FOOD/BEVERAGES. NO FOOD/BEVERAGE SALES.** We will not be selling food or drinks at Moose games to limit interaction & contamination, and there is no outside food/beverage allowed in The Center.
- A hands-free temperature check Kiosk is positioned at the front entrance, and temperatures of all individuals entering The Center will be taken upon arrival.
- Touch free hand sanitizer kiosks are available in all high touch areas throughout rink.
- The designated Entrance is through the sliding doors and designated Exit is through the push door, with clear barricades and signage for traffic flow & 6ft social distancing
- Upon arrival at the rink, segregated areas will be adhered to for the arriving and exiting groups to maintain social distancing. Additional rubber mats & benches have been purchased to expand areas.
- All participants should bring a full personal use water bottle. No sharing of equipment or food will be allowed.
- No more than 12 persons (including players & coaches) allowed on the ice..
- Face coverings are not required by players on the ice during practices and games.
- Spitting anywhere in or around a rink or team is prohibited.
- Each group should designate a person responsible for maintaining compliance within these regulations.

Additional Precautions from SKSEC

- All staff are screened for COVID-19 symptoms prior to arriving to The Center.
- All staff are required to use necessary protective equipment while at The Center.
- Ample signage in front entrance, and high traffic areas is used to remind individuals to “Not enter if they have symptoms of COVID-19, to wear masks at all times while in the rink, and to 6ft socially distance between individuals and individual groups at all times while in The Center.”
- Bathrooms have touchless toilets, touchless soap dispensers, touchless faucets, and touchless air hand dryer.
- Public water fountain is closed. Water bottle refill station is available, and individuals are responsible for their own bottle & equipment.
- Cleaning with electrostatic sprayer is frequent in all high traffic areas.
- UV Air Filter installed for clean, circulating air.
- Additional rubber flooring & benches have been purchased to provide additional distanced seating for skaters.

Individual Responsibility

- We expect all individuals coming to The Center to self-monitor. Before entering, individuals should check temperature and check for any COVID-19 symptoms.
- Participating in social gatherings puts you and others at risk. Consider how your actions outside the rink could affect your participation at The Center.
- Wash your hands with soap and water or hand sanitizer thoroughly prior to arriving at The Center
- Fill water bottles at home and wash regularly.

Given the changing pandemic environment, these regulations may change at any time. Additional regulations will follow as the COVID-19 pandemic continues to evolve.
